Aa	ah (like at the doctor)
Bb	Similar to English B
Cc	2 sounds *similar to English K (with a, o, u) and *English S (with the e & i)
Ch ch	Similar to English Ch (like in Charlie)
Dd	Similar to English D
Ee	ay (as in say)
Ff	Similar to English F
Gg	2 sounds *similar to English G (with a, o, u) and *English H (with e & I)
Hh	<i>Silent</i>
Ii	ee (as in bee)
Jj	Similar to English H
Kk	Similar to English K
Ll	Similar to English L
LLll	Similar to English Y (as in yet)
Mm	Similar to English M
Nn	Similar to English N
Nñ	Sounds like the “ny” in canyon
Oo	oh
Pp	Similar to English P
Qq	Similar to English K
Rr	2 sounds —rolled at the beginning of a word and not rolled in the middle of a word
rr	rolled hard
Ss	Similar to English S
Tt	Similar to English T
Uu	oo (like in boo)
Vv	Similar to English B (a little softer)
Ww	oo (like in boo)
Xx	We don't test the x
Yy	ee (as in bee)
Zz	Similar to English S (in Latin America) or similar to English TH (in Spain)
